S&S UK extends RL Killmore's Cinnamon Falls series with two-book deal

Simon & Schuster UK has acquired two more novels in the Cinnamon Falls series by RL Killmore, a pseudonym for author Necole Ryse.

Charlotte Osment, commissioning editor of adult fiction, acquired world all-language rights to two more books in the series directly from the author.

The first novel in the series, *A Cinnamon Falls Mystery*, was published in August 2025 and has sold 30,000 copies across all formats, with language rights sold in 27 territories so far, according to the publisher. It was longlisted for a **CWA whodunnit dagger** earlier this year.

The two new novels will bring the series publishing into 2027, with a summer book, *Mystery at the Cherry Pie Café*, and a Christmas mystery, *Murder at Candy Cane Market*, planned.

Ryse said: "I am incredibly grateful to continue writing the Cinnamon Falls mystery series with Simon & Schuster UK. These stories, these characters and this town have become so special to me, and I am excited to expand the series

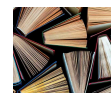

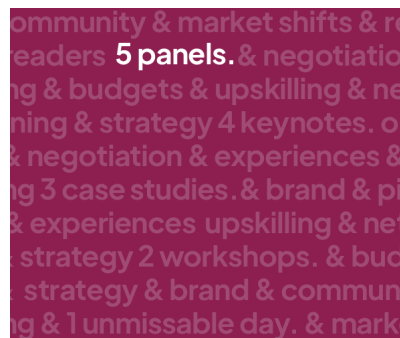
